

Activity	Ballet of the Unhatched Chicks	Mussorgsky	Pre K - Gr. 3
Learning Intentions	<ul> <li>Sing expressively, matching pitch</li> <li>Identify and arrange eggshells for section A, with various four beat rhythm patterns using quarter notes, quarter rests, eighth notes and a whole note.</li> <li>Accompany with simple movement and instrumental play on homemade instruments</li> <li>Dynamic terms piano, forte, and introduction to the terms; legato, staccato and crescendo</li> <li>Introduce students to classical music and Ballet of the Unhatched Chicks by Mussorgsky</li> <li>Introduce students to the composer Mussorgsky</li> <li>Audiation (Inner hearing)</li> <li>Form A B A (ternary)</li> </ul>		
Materials Needed	<ul> <li>Found Sounds: pot/container, homemade shaker, strainer (something scratchy sounding), metal bottle/pot lid, wooden spoons</li> <li>Music map and story</li> <li>Ballet of the Unhatched Chicks by Mussorgsky instrumental version. Fun with Composer's version (available online) or orchestral version available on iTunes.</li> <li>Recommended Children's book: Where do Chicks Come From? by Amy Sklansky</li> </ul>		
Process	<ul> <li>Read students the story of Charli and the Chicks</li> <li>Show students children's book Where do Chicks Come From? – taking time to look at the chick's growth inside the egg and the 21 day (gestation time) before it hatches. Discuss how this would feel on day 21.</li> <li>Demonstrate the sounds heard by playing section A on the hand drum, shaker and claves.</li> <li>Discuss how chicks might move to that sound. Add in actions</li> <li>Demonstrate how after the chicks broke out of their eggshells, they stretched their muscles and did a happy dance. Then they realized their mama and papa weren't there and got back into their shells. Ask students to join you the second time. Return to section A.</li> <li>Review it from the beginning with the music with lyrics and then orchestral music.</li> <li>Discuss -add in instruments to each phrase in the sections as demonstrated in the video.</li> <li>Introduce the music map having students conduct in the air to the music. Discuss how the map reflects the music. Distribute maps at the end of class.</li> <li>Introduce students to the composer Mussorgsky. Distribute colouring image at end</li> </ul>
